

Synod News: Practical Information on our Listening Lent

The K&L Synod Committee is preparing templates for parishes to use in listening sessions during Lent. Parishes are very welcome to join with other parishes in hosting these sessions. We will also be offering an online survey that we ask parishes to promote during Lent. Parishioners might be invited to take out their phones at an appropriate point at Mass, perhaps during the homily, and find the link to the survey for use later. While the diocesan committee will host focus groups during Lent, Parishes are also very welcome to identify particular groups they wish to hear from using the template as a tool. The intentional listening that might take place between two people over a cup of coffee will be equally welcome

A youth listening template will be offered also.

Digital submissions from parishes will be able to be submitted to a dedicated email address Guidelines for how the submissions can be assembled will also be offered in due course.

Towards a Synodal Church,

On 7th March 2021 Pope Francis convoked the 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops, to be held in October 2023 on the theme: "For a synodal Church: - Communion, Participation and Mission".

Over the coming weeks we here in the Parishes of Mountrath – Ballyfin will be meeting to prepare our submission to be presented to the Diocese – At the end of May after conducting consultation and listening, and after hosting a Synodal gathering to synthesize the fruits of this consultation, each diocese will submit their Synodal document to the Irish Bishops' Conference.

We will be engaging with 3 Questions

- 1. Thinking about the Church and about my local Parish, how and when did I find being part of it a source of joy or nourishment for me in my Faith When migh it bring me disappointment or pain?
 - 2. When I hear the word "Church" who do I think of ? Who is missing? Whom do we need to listen to ? How can we become more inclusive?
- 3. Thinking about how we as Parish community bring the love of Christ into the world, what one thing does our local Parish do really well? What one thing could it do better with? What one thing could I do?

All parishioners are invited to a Meeting to make submissions about the way forward for the church. These submissions will be forwarded to the preparatory committee of the forthcoming Synod. This is your opportunity to have your say about the church. This meeting will take place in the Bloom Centre in the Chapel of the old convent on Wed. 23rd March - 7.30 pm - 930 pm. If you don't get through to the call centre and a message saying "1850 numbers no longer accepted" could you ring the following phone number 053-937 6400 (then press option 4). Your monitor just needs to be re-programmed. You will be guided over the phone what to do. This only refers to alarms connected to a Landline.

If you are interested in finding out more about Senior Personal Alarms phone Rita Watkins on 086 301 5793. Applications accepted from people aged 65 years up, you don't have to live alone. Your monitor and pendant are free, as is the first years rental. From year two you pay a small annual fee.
