Painting of Mountrath Church.

The painting of Mountrath Church is due to begin over the next couple of weeks. The painting work will commence in the Sanctuary area. As I said when I was chatting you during Mass recently, the painting of Mountrath Church will involve a fair amount of disruption disruption which cannot be avoided. When commencing the painting, our first task will be to temporarily move the altar to a raised platform outside the altar rails. This is required to allow the entire sanctuary area to be scaffolded out in full (to the roof) When the scaffolding is in place and ready all walls to be painted will get a thorough clean down - all walls will be repaired and filled (where necessary) - when this preparatory work is completed, three coats of emulsion paint will be applied to the walls. It is impossible to put a time frame on the duration of this work but it is estimated that it will take at least a month / five weeks. Please God. it will be all worth it.
