Friday, 27 Oct. - Pope Francis calls for World Day of Fasting and Prayer for Peace

In his weekly general audience last week, Pope Francis invited people throughout the world to a day of fasting and prayer for peace in the Israel – Hamas conflict on 27 Oct. 2023. He also announced that on that day at 6:00 p.m. (5 pm Irish time) in St. Peter's Basilica, he will lead an hour of prayer "in the spirit of penance" to implore God for "peace in our days, peace in this world,"
