

Edward Lalor (1939-2024)

Edward Lalor, popularly known as Eddie, was born on the 17th of September 1939 at Cappanaclough in the parish of Raheen, Co Laois, to Thomas Lalor and his wife Agnes (née Brennan). Eddie had two sisters and one brother. Eddie attended Raheen Primary School from 1944 to 1951 and Abbeyleix Primary School from 1951 to 1952. Eddie had his secondary education in the Patrician College Ballyfin as a boarder from 1952 to 1956.

In September 1956 Eddie joined the Spiritual Year in Kiltegan. From 1957 to 1960 he studied for his B.Sc. Degree in University College, Cork, and then proceeded to Kiltegan for theology from 1960 until 1964. Eddie was among twenty priests ordained for St Patrick's Missionary Society by Bishop Cleary on March 29th, 1964.

After ordination, Eddie was appointed to Kenya where he was to spend the rest of his missionary life. He worked first in Eldoret Diocese from 1964 to 1968, before transferring to Nakuru Diocese where he remained until 1984. He began his missionary work teaching in the Minor Seminary. He also taught in an army secondary school and different parishes, including the cathedral in Nakuru, Njoro and Baraka. He was Vocations Director in the diocese for a number of years.

In 1984, Eddie was elected as the Society's Regional Superior for East Africa, a post he held for the next twelve years. During these years he looked after all our missionaries in Kenya and Sudan and guided and supported their ministries in parishes and schools. He helped to co-ordinate many development programmes to enhance the lives of the people.

In 1997 Eddie returned to parish work and opened up a new parish in Embakasi, Nairobi, where St Patrick's priests still minister. After two years he moved into hospital chaplaincy in Kenyatta Hospital, Nairobi. He made a great contribution to the life of the hospital and provided spiritual comfort to the patients and assisted many of them by helping to pay their hospital bills. He also developed a great working relationship with all the staff who relied on him for advice and spiritual support.

Eddie returned to Ireland in 2013 and worked in the parish of Portlaoise. He spent seven very happy years there, where he had the opportunity to minister to the people of his native county. The people of Portlaoise appreciated his kindness and humility and were blessed with the rich wisdom he shared with them from his experience in Africa.

In 2020 Eddie developed serious health issues, and he moved back to Kiltegan where he underwent a lot of medical treatment. He was lovingly cared for by the staff of the Care Unit whom he was constantly thanking for their attentiveness and care. On January 2nd, 2024, he was admitted to St Vincent's hospital in Dublin. He died there peacefully just before midday on January 9th, with his sister Eleanor, niece Emma and Fr David Larkin SPS by his bedside.

Eddie was a very committed missionary who spent 49 years in Kenya where he loved the country and its people. He always had great heart for the poor and the weak whom he supported with the help of his family and many friends in Ireland. During his years as Regional Leader in East Africa Eddie devoted great care and attention to the Society's mission in Sudan which had begun the year before he took up office. His encouragement to all who worked in Sudan was exceptional.

Eddie is predeceased by his parents Thomas and Agnes, his brother P.J. and sister Annette. He is survived by his sister Eleanor Robinson, his nephews Patrick and Eddie and nieces Emma and Una and their families, and his Society family.

Brigid 1500

On Thurs. 1st Feb. 2024, Churches across Kildare and Leighlin, and beyond, will come together to participate in a special ecumenical service at 11.00am in St Brigid's Cathedral, Kildare entitled, 'Celebrating St Brigid. Brigid 1500: A Service of Thanksgiving' dedicated to commemorating the Feast Day of St Brigid and the 1500th anniversary of her death.

The co-leaders of this thanksgiving service are the Most Rev Denis Nulty, Roman Catholic Bishop of Kildare and Leighlin, and the Most Rev Patricia Storey, Church of Ireland Bishop of Meath and Kildare. The Reverend Canon Dr. Alison Joyce, Rector of St. Bride's Church, Fleet Street in the heart of London, will deliver the sermon.

At the end of the Service, a Pause for Peace will be observed in the Cathedral at 12 noon. Aligning with a broader initiative whereby the people of Kildare are extending a global invitation, urging individuals worldwide to pause for a minute's silence at midday (local time) on St Brigid's Day, the 1st of February 2024. Christian Unity Week

At least once a year, Christians are reminded of Jesus' prayer for his disciples that "they may be one so that the world may believe" (see John 17.21). Hearts are touched and Christians come together to pray for their unity. Congregations and parishes all over the world exchange preachers or arrange special ecumenical celebrations and prayer services. The event that touches off this special experience is the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, held each year at the end of January.

To prepare for the annual celebration, ecumenical partners in a particular region of the world are invited to produce a basic liturgical text on a biblical theme. The materials for the 2024 Week of Prayer for Christian Unity were prepared by an ecumenical team from Burkina Faso, in West Africa. The theme chosen is "You shall love the Lord your God ... and your neighbour as yourself" (Lk 10:27). Representatives from the Catholic Archdiocese, Protestant Churches, ecumenical bodies collaborated generously in drafting the prayers and reflections.

These prayers and reflections will be part of an Ecumenical Service which will take place in St. Edmund's Church, Castletown, on Sun. 28th Janu. at 3pm. We hope to have representatives from different Christian denominations in attendance. All parishioners are welcome as we gather to pray and reflect with our Christian brothers and sisters.

Refreshments will be served afterwards in De La Salle Centre.
