Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes Thurs. 11th Feb.

On this day in 1858, Our Lady first appeared to a 14 year old girl, Bernadette Soubirous. Later Bernadette was to learn that the mysterious lady was the Blessed Virgin and to hear from her lips, "I am the Immaculate Conception" In 1992 Pope John Paul 2 (St. John Paul) instituted World Day of the Sick to be held in commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes on this day.

A Thought as we celebrate Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes.

I was listening to "Morning Ireland" on RTE Radio I recently. During the programme a lady was interviewed concerning the situation with residents and staff of our Nursing Homes. What upset me most was the statement this person made, that many residents of Nursing Homes in Ireland have not received a family visit since March of last year – since the beginning of the 1st lockdown.

When we are ill and confined to our bed at home, in Hospital or in a Nursing Home we rely so much on a visit from one of our own or from a friend. Just a smile, a kind word, an embrace or the touch of a hand – just something that denotes presence. I know that current circumstances dictate that visits to our loved ones in Hospital and Nursing Homes must be avoided to ensure the safety of residents and staff but it is just so cruel, all the same.

On Thursday of this week we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, a feast which Pope John Paul designated as World Day of the Sick. Here in Mountrath on this feast day we celebrated the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick during Mass. Because of the Lockdown, when we are restricted to celebrating the Eucharist behind closed doors we will be unable to celebrate this Sacrament in its fullness, this year. However as Fr. P.J and myself concelebrate this Mass together on Thursday next we will be reaching out in a very special way to all who are sick or unwell in both our Parishes - and indeed, beyond. We will be remembering people who are now living in Nursing Homes, people who are in Hospital and people who are confined to their bed at home. As we remember people who are ill we will be keeping in our thoughts and prayers also those who continue to care for them – those who surround them with their love and care, - I am thinking of family members (and carers) who dedicate themselves to the care of a loved one, staff and carers in Hospitals and Nursing Homes, very mindful of the personal risks to themselves and their families which they are taking at this time.
