Painting of Mountrath Church.

Following on from my chat with you during recent Masses, I write to let you know that I have begun planning the painting of Mountrath Church once again. As I said during my chat with you some weeks back. because of the Covid Pandemic, all my previous planning and all the arrangements which I had in place, had to be abandoned. (not once, but twice over) Please God, all going well we will get on better this time round.

I need to say from the outset, that the painting of Mountrath Church is a big job and it is going to be a very difficult task to undertake. Speaking with my builder's hat on for a moment, one of the major challenges which we will encounter will be access – access initially to the Church building itself and subsequently safe access to the areas to be painted. To put what I am saying into context, the apex of Mountrath Church stands 65 meters above ground. - in old money, this is well over 210 feet. It will be a huge challenge to provide and erect scaffolding to access all wall surfaces, which will be painted, safely and efficiently.

I am currently in contact with a number of painters and others, with a view to getting a "feel" for costings of scaffolding hire, paints and painting and the provision of other requirements.

I am making 3 Special Requests of you now.

If you know someone, whom you feel to be competent to undertake the painting (all or part) of Mountrath Church, (and would be interested in doing so) I ask you to get in contact with me and let me know. I have a very strong preference to engage local people - if possible.
As I said, also, I can't take on the painting of Mountrath Church without significant help and support from you as Parish. If <u>you</u> would like to become involved in the organizing committee, or if you know someone whom you feel would like to be involved, and would be competent to do so, I ask you to get in contact with me and let me know.

If you feel you know someone who would provide some sponsorship towards aspects of the painting job, (I am thinking of someone (or indeed more) who would look after the cost – for example, of the paint) I ask you to get in contact with me and let me know.

It is a bit early yet to discuss the costings of the painting of Mountrath Church. I'm sure we will have to do some serious fundraising in due course, but for now, all I will say is that because of the trogon work and coutineuos commitment of Mountrath Lotto Committee and indeed all who so generously support our Parish Lotto every week, as well as the proceeds of the Three Tenors Concert (21st Feb. '20) and also some personal donations which I have received towards the cost of the painting, we do have quite significant funds available to us.

My final thought for now – as I write this note, is, – with the good will and commitment of the people of Mountrath Parish. we can and we will, undertake and complete the painting of Mountrath Church soon. God's blessings to you and your family, always

National Synthesis of Synodal Process

The national synthesis – which has now been submitted to the Synod Secretariat in the Vatican as part of the global synodal process announced by Pope Francis for the Church is available to read and download on <u>www.kandle.ie</u>

Dr Nicola Brady, Chair of the Synod Steering Committee, said, "We invite everyone to read the national synthesis and reflect on what we are called to do, as individuals and as a church community, as a result of what we have heard. The issues raised are not new, but the honesty and clarity with which they have been articulated in this process, and the relational approach that has characterised the work to date, offers a strong foundation to build upon. Some of the findings are stark, many of the experiences shared are painful, but there have also been many hopeful and encouraging aspects, notably the importance many people have placed on this process and the skills and experience we will take forward into the subsequent phases of this work. Important questions have been set out for deeper reflection and pastoral action at every level of Church life and there will be many more opportunities for people to get involved and help shape this process."
