Question - Will we be allowed to celebrate Mass in Mountrath Cemetery in June of this year.

Answer - Under current restrictions we are not permitted to celebrate Mass in Mountrath Cemetery for the time being - Hopefully this will change over coming months

Some Guidelines - As we return to Public Worship

The maximum allowed into Mountrath Church for Mass is 100 people (50 x 2)
3 people may be seated in the centre seats only - while observing social distancing

Families may be seated together in one seat

The maximum allowed into the Hollow Church for Mass is 45 people.
3 people may be seated in the "Open" seats only - while observing social distancing

Families may be seated together in one seat

People who enter the church for Mass may occupy the "open" seats only.

It is not correct to occupy seats which have been closed off.

Holy Communion may be received on the hand only.

Bishop Denis asks that face coverings be worn during Mass.
