

Arrangements for Anniversary Mass remembrances and Month's Mind Masses are, more often than not, now arranged by email, text message, whatsapp, by phone, among many other ways. Which is great.

On the down-side, it can be quiet difficult to keep track of all these ways. Sometimes emails can go to folders on the computer other than the main folder and
are not seen straight away. The same can apply to text messages and Whatsapp.
messages. This can cause a problem when I have no knowledge of these emails /
messages coming in and are sometimes not detected at the time.

Dear grandparents and dear grandchildren, good morning and welcome!

I greet Archbishop Vincenzo Paglia and all those who collaborated to organize this moment of celebration. And particular thanks go to the many show-business personalities who wished to participate. Thank you! We all have a grandfather or a grandmother, two grandfathers, two grandmothers. Having a grandparent is a beautiful experience. But even Italy has a "grandfather", and for this reason, I want to greet "the grandfather of Italy", [Lino Banfi (pictured)], who is present here.

It is nice to welcome you here, grandparents and grandchildren, young and not so young. Today we see, as the Psalm says, how good it is to be together (cf. Ps 133). One has but to look at you to understand this, because there is love between you. And it is precisely on this that I would like us to reflect a moment: on the fact that love makes us better, it makes us richer and it makes us wiser, at any age.

First: love makes us better. You too show this, that you make each other better by loving each other. And I say this to you as a "grandfather", with the desire to share the ever-youthful faith that unites all generations. I too received it from my grandmother, from whom I first learned about Jesus who loves us, who never leaves us alone, and who urges us too to be close to each other and never to exclude anyone. I still remember the first prayers my grandmother taught me. It was from her that I heard the story of that family where there was the grandfather



Memo re. World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly – 28^{th} July 2024

Pope Francis has in recent years designated the Sunday closest to the Feast of Ss.

Joachim and Anne as 'World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly'. The National

Pilgrimage of the Catholic Grandparents Association takes place that day in Knock and indeed the theme of Reek Sunday is also this year being dedicated to World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly. This is the 4th World Day and the theme this year is 'Do not cast me off in my old age' (Ps.71:9) I would ask you to do what you can to promote this day at parish/diocesan level. Grandparents and the Elderly are central components of the life of every parish.

A few possible ways to celebrate the Day:

- I suggest that a candle be lit in the sanctuary of every church by a grandparent or an older person to recognise, acknowledge and celebrate the contribution of grandparents and the elderly to our parishes
- Both the Message from Pope Francis and his Audience Address from 27 April last provide great stimulation for a homily (both attached)
- I also attach sample 'Prayers of the Faithful' kindly composed by Fr. Seamus
 O'Connell (St. Patrick's Pontifical University, Maynooth) for use on the day, I am
 attaching a PDF and Word version, in case there may be local edits required. He
 has tied in the prayers beautifully to the scripture of the day.
- I enclose a reflection written by Betty Murphy (Carlow) one of the founder members of the Catholic Grandparents Association on what it means to be part of that association and indeed to be a grandparent.

 Finally the Catholic Grandparents Prayer written by Pope Benedict XVI and a more recent Prayer offered by the Dicastery – either could work as a Post Communion Reflection
